





Travelling to the beautiful Lofoten Islands, the jewel of Norway



Flight from Oslo to Svolvaer crossing the Escandes mountain range, islands and fjords. Landing in the spectacular Lofoten Islands, 250 km above the Arctic Circle on the Nordland's region

01 April, 2023

North of Lofoten: Rubber boat expedition to the Raftsundet & Trollfjord



10.00. RUBBER BOAT AND EAGLE SAFARI (3 HOURS)

Equipment with floating suits. Your skipper will take you on a private rib boat tour to enjoy the mountains, hundreds of islands and the spectacular north coast. During the expedition you will enjoy local wildlife as cormorants, eiders and white-tailed eagles, specie protected since 1978. Scenic itinerary

You will skirt the impressive mountains of the Vest Fjord till Raftsundet (Strait of Raft), to enter on the scenic Troll Fjord, one of the most emblematic places of the islands. It is well known for its stunning beauty, steep mountain range and narrow inlets



13.00. Arrival to Henningsvaer, a unique arctic fishing village between bridges and islands and well known because of its wooden drying cods.



13.30. Lunch in a local restaurant.

Enjoy the afternoon on your own in Henningsvaer to walk and visit the town, maybe some shopping...



16.30. Return to your lodge by car. Enjoy the views to Vagakallen Mountain from your terrace maybe with a coffee or a glass of wine...

The sauna will be ready for those who wish. It is also possible a plunge into the ocean from the lodge



20.00. Today's dinner will be served in a local restaurant in Svolvaer to meet the local atmosphere

02 April, 2023

South of Lofoten: white beaches and fishing towns



10.00. LOFOTEN SIGHTSEEING TO THE SOUTH BY PRIVATE ROAD. Today you will discover with your guide and a private vehicle the scenic roads of Lofoten towards south.

Stops on the strategic places as wild beaches of white sand and turquoise waters. Glacier valleys, granite mountains, polar fishing villages await us during this day.

"Arctic Brunch" in a beautiful spot.

Continue to the arctic fishing village of Nusfjord or Sakrisoy; depending on the weather conditions we will take different routes.



14.00. Lunch in a local restaurant.

In the afternoon return to your hotel while discovering new landscapes and views. Scenic itinerary on your way back.

O3 April, 2O23 Travelling to Tromso, the Arctic Gate



SNOWSHOEING IN THE MORNING. You will put on modern snowshoes to access the snowy hills and frozen lakes. Snowshoes have been used for centuries by indigenous communities living long winters in the snow; the nowadays version are made of lightweight aluminum that fits any walking boots. You will have your personal guide for this activity. Lunch will be served after the activity.

13.25. FLIGHT SVOLVAER-BODO-TROMSO.

16.25. Arrival at Tromso airport and private transfer to your hotel, located a few meters from the port.

Accommodation in a Superior room with views to the Strait of Troms.

POLAR MUSEUM IN PRIVATE FOR THE GROUP. We will introduce you in the world of the arctic hunters and explorers one day before travelling to the Svalbard island. This briefing will give you the opportunity to know more about the lands you will discover in the next days.



Dinner will be served in one of the best restaurants in the city where we will continue trying some arctic specialties.

After dinner, we can enjoy a drink together at one of the lively live music venues in the city.

12.20. FLIGHT TROMSO - LONGYEARBYEN (SVALBARD ISLANDS) . During the flight you will cross the Arctic Ocean



14.00. Arrival at Longyearbyen at 78° North, the northernmost town in the planet and private transfer to your "arctic hotel" located in the center of Longyearbyen.

Accommodation and lunch in a local restaurant.

SVALBARD POLFAREREN HOTEL: With 31 brand new "arctic designed" rooms, newer and better facilities. Centrally located in Longyearbyen, Svalbard Hotel offers a terrace and modern comfortable rooms. Complimentary tea and coffee is available in the lobby.

19.00. SNOWMOBILE EVENING EXPERIENCE IN THE ADVENTVALLEY. Today's goal is having the first contact with the equipment, the terrain and the equipment while discovering the special light of Svalbard on April. It will be a training experience for tomorrow's full day snowmobile safari

You will drive your own snowmobile (Remember to bring your driving license)

05 April, 2023

Snowmobile expedition in the realm of polar bears



7.00- 10.00. Hotel breakfast



9.00. FULL DAY SNOWMOBILE SAFARI IN THE LAND OF POLAR BEARS After providing you some equipment and safety instructions, you will start by driving your single snowmobiles along Spitsbergen Island and the remote landscapes (remember to bring your driving license)

During the itinerary you will do some photographic stops and enjoy the polar wildlife (seals, wild reindeers, may be a polar bear...). You will drive through mountainous landscapes and reach the blue glaciers fronts falling into de iced sea.

With snowmobiles you will cross the marine ice, glaciers and you will find remains of hunter(s) old cabins in the middle of the remotest scenery.

Expedition lunch.

In the afternoon, continue driving the snowmobiles discovering new arctic landscapes and the amazing arctic light.



17.00. Return to Longyearbyen in the afternoon and transfer to your hotel for a well deserved rest

Today 's dinner will be on your own so you can try one of the restaurants in Longyearbyen. Our staff will be glad to assist you with your bookings.

06 April, 2023 Dogsledding adventure



7.00-10.00. Hotel breakfast

DOGSLEDDING TO THE ICE . After a short stop to get some equipment, you will be to "Trapper's Station", one of the best dog farms in Longyearbyen located 10 km from Longyearbyen. There, you will learn how to prepare your sleighs following directions from our guides and choosing the appropriate dogs.

Then you will go through the Bolterdalen valley in a crossing of about 6 hours long. Surrounded by the Svalbard mountains and with your dogs and the silence as a companion, you will hear the sound of your skis as they slide over the snow to arrive to the ice caves.

You will get into the caves wearing helmets and front lights. Expedition lunch (dehydrated food).

Return to the farm dog where you will have a hot cup of tea or coffee gathered around the bonfire sharing the anecdotes and experiences of the day.



15.00. **Return to Longyearbyen** in the afternoon and transfer to your hotel. Afternoon on your own



20.00. Farewell dinner will be served in the most emblematic restaurant in Longyearbyen

The Lofoten Islands

This archipelago is placed in the Nordland's region at 69° latitude and 187 miles to the north of the Arctic Circle. It is a mountain range which emerges dramatically from the sea, dominated by rough ocean's landscapes and fjords sculpted in the last glacial era.

Its inhabitants, joyful and welcoming, spend their time fishing "Skrei" and whaling. The small villages sprinkle crammed bays between granite walls and turquoise blue beaches while hundreds of islets and skerries appear and disappear with the tides.

The currents of the islands were mentioned by writers as Jules Verne or Edgar Allan Poe. The changing weather, the saline lakes, the white-tailed eagles and the small fishing and whaling villages with their wooden drying cods are very special and make this archipelago really unique.

Tromso

It is the capital of the Troms' region and the most important city of the north of the country. Its streets and harbor reflect a past of polar adventures. Until here arrived important expeditions from the most northern areas of the high Arctic. In this town you get a lively atmosphere, mainly because here is set the most northerly university of the planet. Its polar museums and its restaurants have a lot to offer.

Here we find one of the most important observatories on the whole Arctic. It specializes on studies of cosmic radiation, mete orology, northern lights and the earth's magnetic field.

The region where it is settled is formed by small fishing villages where the Sami culture is still latent.

At the Tromso port, different ships arrive rhythmically with varied objectives (fishing, transportation, scientific expeditions, cargo, tourism...).


The city is surrounded with a privileged landscape between the Strait of Troms, Tromsoya and Kvaloy islands and the mountain s.

The Svalbard islands

Is a Norwegian archipelago in the Arctic Ocean. Situated midway between continental Norway and the North Pole. The islands of the group range from 74°to 81°north latitude. The largest island is Spitsbergen, followed by Nordaustlandet and Edgeøya. While part of the Kingdom of Norway since 1925, Svalbard is not part of geographical Norway proper; administratively, the archipelago is not part of any Norwegian county.

Since 2002, Svalbard's main settlement, Longyearbyen, has had an elected local government, somewhat similar to mainland municipalities. Other settlements include the Russian mining community of Barentsburg, the research station of Ny-Ålesund, and the mining outpost of Sveagruva. Other settlements are farther north, but are populated only by rotating groups of researchers.

The archipelago features an Arctic climate, although with significantly higher temperatures than other areas at the same latitude. Svalbard is a breeding ground for many seabirds, and also features polar bears, reindeer, the Arctic fox, and certain marine mammals. Approximately 60% of the archipelago is covered with glaciers, and the islands feature many mountains and fjords.
